#### **Reconfirmation Meeting for December 2020**

#### Reconfirm the current instructional delivery method:

All K-5 general education in-person instruction, and 6-8 general education in-person instruction transitioned from being hybrid (2-day in-person) with a fully remote option, to a fully remote distance learning model on Monday, 11/16/20. Grades 9-12 general education instruction remained fully remote as the high school transitioned to 2<sup>nd</sup> trimester on Monday, 11/30/20.

All general education students in grades K-12 are now following the distance learning model as outlined in the <u>COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan</u> that the Mason Board of Education adopted on 8/10/20.

General education instruction for grades K-12 will remain fully remote until January 2021. The Board of Education will re-assess in December and January where the Mason community is in terms of the spread of COVID-19 and whether there will be changes to the current K-12 general education instructional delivery method.

# Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

All K-12 special education students in basic classrooms are receiving in-person instruction for half-a-day, 4 days per week with Wednesdays being fully remote.

This delivery model provides personalized attention to students, with appropriate social distancing. The classrooms split the students into two small groups (A.M. and P.M.) to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

The model for basic classrooms will be re-evaluated every 30 days.
