Virtual Learning Contract

This Virtual Learning Contract serves as an agreement between the student, the parent/guardian, and the Mason Public Schools district. By signing this contract, the parties involved commit to fulfilling their responsibilities and obligations in order to ensure a successful virtual learning experience. Please carefully read and understand the following requirements, expectations, and commitments

Student Expectations

- Students must have access to a reliable internet connection and a suitable device (computer, laptop, or tablet) capable of running the required software for virtual learning.
- Students must possess basic computer skills and be comfortable navigating online platforms, accessing digital resources, and using communication tools.
- Students must adhere to the district's acceptable use policy for technology and online resources.
- Students are expected to maintain regular attendance and actively participate in all virtual learning activities, including synchronous and asynchronous sessions, discussions, assignments, and assessments.
- Students must follow the established virtual learning schedule and meet deadlines for submitting assignments and completing assessments.
- Students are required to take full responsibility for their own learning, actively seeking help and clarification when needed.
- Students must maintain a respectful and inclusive online presence, engaging in constructive and appropriate communication with peers, teachers, and staff.
- Students are responsible for regularly checking their school email, online learning platforms, and other communication channels for updates and announcements.

Parent Expectations

- The district will establish clear channels of communication and support between students, parents, teachers, and staff to address any concerns, questions, or technical issues that may arise during virtual learning.
- The district will maintain regular communication with students and parents, providing updates on virtual learning expectations, schedules, and any changes or modifications to the program.
- The district will assess student progress and provide timely feedback to support their academic growth and success.
- The district will adhere to student privacy and data protection regulations, ensuring the security and confidentiality of student information.

Consequences for Non-Compliance

Failure to comply with the terms and expectations outlined in this Virtual Learning Contract may result in the following consequences:

- Student may receive a warning and be required to attend a virtual meeting with a school administrator or teacher to discuss the issue and develop a plan for improvement.
- Student may be assigned additional coursework or remedial activities to make up for missed or incomplete assignments.
- Student's grades and academic progress may be negatively affected.
- Student may face limitations or restrictions on participation in extracurricular activities or events.
- Student may be subject to disciplinary action as outlined in the school district's policies and guidelines, including but not limited to suspension or expulsion from virtual learning.
- Continued non-compliance may result in the termination of virtual learning privileges, requiring the student to return to in-person learning, if available.
