'A FOR EFFORT' BEGINNING METAL WORK CLASS

Ever wanted to learn how to cut, weld and grind steel into a work of art or practical project, but don't know where to start? This introductory 1-day class is designed to give you the hands-on experience and know-how to practice welding in various positions for different purposes and give you some idea of costs/tools to consider if you'd like to do more of this type of work on your own. Students will learn proper tool safety for MIG welding, Metal Band saw use, Iron Worker operation, Angle Grinder use as well as proper application of Personal Protective Equipment while using these tools. Students will spend the first half of class familiarizing themselves and practicing with the aforementioned shop tools, qualifying to use them independently during the second portion of the class. During the second half of the class, students will design and build a welding project of their own either from an idea they bring to class or from several examples provided by the instructor (for the time/budget limit of this introductory class smaller projects are preferred). Price includes all equipment, metal, safety equipment, drinks/snacks. Pick a class that best fits your schedule. Class size will stay very small (4) to ensure safety. Lifeguard Instructor Certification requires all students to complete the online Blended Learning prior to the first day of class. You will need to pay \$35 when registering for the class directly to the American Red Cross, then register online and pay for the remainder of the class. Upon completion of this class, you will be eligible to instruct Lifequarding Classes. You must attend all in class sessions along with online learning. You will also be given 2-3 skills in which you will be required to teach and be evaluated by the lead instructor. You must be at least 17 years of age to participate. Location: Mason High School.

LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION - BLENDED LEARNING

Lifequards are always in demand and if you are committed to helping prevent drownings, this is the class for you. In this program, you will learn CPR/FA/AED & water skills. Classroom work will provide valuable information from trainers with years of experience. Prerequisites: Must be 15 years of age on or before the final exam. Swim 300 yards continuously demonstrating rhythmic breathing. Candidates may swim using the front crawl, breaststroke, or a combination of both but swimming on your back or side is not allowed. Swim goggles may be used. You must also be able to tread water for 2 minutes using only your legs (hands under armpits) and complete a timed event within 1 minute and 40 seconds. Students must pass all water tests and written exam with an 80% or higher. This is a blended learning course. MUST ATTEND ALL SESSIONS AND COMPLETE ONLINE LEARNING PORTION OF CLASS PRIOR TO THE FIRST MEETING DATE. You will be emailed the link to the Blended Learning Portion of the class.

LIFEGUARD RECERTIFICATION

All skills will be reviewed and practiced before water and written test. CPR/FA/AED are included in the review. 

Swim Lessons F.A.Q.

- 1. Where is the pool located? The pool is located at the High School 1001 S. Barnes St., Mason, MI 48854 at the north end of the building by the tennis courts- opposite side of the school from the football field.
- 2. What Should I bring? Your towel, swimsuit, goggles, & any personal items you might need. Have long hair tied back. Men's, women's and family locker room are available to use.
- 3. What time should I arrive? 5-10 minutes before your class time.
- 4. <u>Can I stay and watch?</u> Yes, but please sit on the bleachers or in the upstairs balcony and do not interfere with the child's lesson.
- 5. What level should I sign my child up for? Each lesson description has information on what is taught in each level,. You can read the information and then make a decision based on their abilities. Any other questions email agavittm@masonk12.net
- 6. Are swim lessons the only ones in the pool? No, often the pool is being utilized by other groups. 95% of our lessons are held in the shallow end for safety. All groups work together to ensure everyone has the space they need available.
- 7. Why are there not more days/times offered? We understand classes are limited and fill very quickly and that is frustrating. However, we can only offer the number of classes we have staff and pool space for. Your child's safety during lessons is our #1 priority.
- 8. When are classes? Classes will take place on Saturdays from April 22 May 20, 2023. This is a 5 week session.
- 9. <u>Is the pool warm?</u> Mason Aquatic Center is a competitive pool. It is heated to 82* but this can feel chilly to many. We highly recommend long sleeved bathing suits when swimming here. We cannot raise the temperature just for lessons.



SPRING SWIM LESSONS (APRIL 22-MAY 20, 2023)

Water Babies (6 Months - 2.5 Years) (30 minutes) No experience required. The focus of this class is to create a nurturing aquatic environment through songs, activities, and parent/child bonding. Adults will learn safety tips to keep you and your child safe in and around water. Children not potty trained must wear a swim diaper. Adult must be in the water with the child. Class limit: 10

Fin Buddies (2.5 - 4 Years) (30 minutes) No previous experience and/or less than 42" height. Techniques taught include floating on front/back, kicking, water adjustment, under water exploration, and basic water safety. Children not potty trained must wear a swim diaper. Adult must be in the water with the child. Class limit: 10

Make A Splash (4 - 5 Years) (30 minutes) Previous class experience & 42" height requirement. This class is for young swimmers who are ready to make the transition from parent and child class, but not quite ready for a Level Class. Continuation of water adjustment skills and self exploration in the water along with skill training. Students must be potty trained to attend this class. Class Limit: 4

Level 1 (30 minutes) Recommended child height of 48". Students will work on water entrances/exits, blowing bubbles, water bobbing, floating on front/back, rolling front to back, safety, and learning combined arm and leg action. Class limit:5/10 (depending on staff availability)

<u>Do I have to be a good swimmer?</u> You must be able to swim at least 50 yards of Freestyle and 25 yards of Backstroke (without stopping) with correct technique or have completed Level 4 of the Swim Lesson classes to do Bronze level. MASC is NOT a learn to swim program.
