## Mason Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Professional Development February 25, 2022

On Friday, February 25, Mason Public Schools instructional staff took part in a full day of professional development (PD). The day built on the diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) efforts our district has leaned into over the last two years. The learning focused on the theme: Ensuring students have equity in access by affirming and supporting them so they receive equitable benefits from school.

2. How might we integrate these ideas into practice?
3. What are our next steps?
4. How will we measure it?
5. How might we hold our team accountable?
6. What might we need more of?
7. What might we need less of?
8. How can we incorporate student voice in this process?
9. What are our barriers?
10. What are our opportunities?
11. What will we do to move through the barriers?
12. How will we know we have moved forward as a school community?
