Welcome - Committee Chair

Mary Hilker welcomed the group to the meeting.

Reports/Discussion

Director of Student Supports

Craig Kueffner updated the group on the continued work on the Strategic Plan process. The DEI focus is the bedrock of the plan. Four groups are working on the goals and action steps. These are due May 31.

The Student Perception Survey captured input from 71% of our students in the 5th through 12th grades. This is an outstanding result. The preliminary results were reviewed by the executive team. The final report will be shared out when available. The committee discussed strategies for using the data and transparency.

Craig reported on sharing Heritage Months' information with staff. Feedback included thankfulness and sometimes included recommendations for other areas to acknowledge and develop.

Brainstorming for 2023-24 Activity - Craig led the committee in a quick exercise to guide work for the start of the year. He shared the committee's ideas.

Consultant - virtual attendance

Karlin presented an exercise on Mental Health Awareness Month as it relates to DEI. The group defined mental health. Mental health is on a continuum. The committee shared what they believe is mental illness. Karlin shared key ideas for addressing mental illness when a person loses the ability to function daily. It is essential to normalize mental health. Karlin shared the four tiers of Social Emotional Learning - the first three are school-based. The committee viewed the chart on Culturally Responsive Positive Behavior Intervention Supports. Important concepts were reviewed. The group discussed the three main issues for students: anxiety, depression, and exposure to trauma. Protocols for students and adults are necessary.
