ALAIEDON RAISES NATIONAL BLUE RIBBON SCHOOL FLAG

Last fall, it was announced that Alaiedon Elementary, one of Mason Public Schools' exemplary elementary schools, was named a 2021 National Blue Ribbon School (NBRS). The award from the U.S. Department of Education is based on a school's success in maintaining high academic performance or progress in closing achievement gaps among student subgroups. This prestigious award has been given to Alaiedon Elementary for consistently maintaining high M-STEP (Michigan Student Test of

Educational Progress) scores for all grades and being a top performing school in the State of Michigan.

In October, the district held a celebration and ceremonial ribbon cutting with the community and district leadership. Since then, the U.S. Department of Education has given Alaiedon a flag to fly above the building in perpetuity.

On May 31, students, staff, members of the community and Board of Education came together to officially raise the flag.

BUSINESS AND ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS REMAIN LOW

The Michigan Department of Education has recently published the annual Bulletin 1014. In this report, Mason Public Schools has maintained a ranking for low total business and administrative costs per student compared to other Michigan districts for the years ending June 30, 2015 – 2021.

For the year ending 2021, MPS was ranked 666 out of 821 schools, maintaining a position in the lowest 4.1% of schools in Michigan for the lowest business and administrative cost per student. This is one of those instances when it's good to be ranked at the bottom. For the last six fiscal years, Mason Public Schools has been ranked in the lowest 8.4% of all school districts in the state, for the lowest business and administrative cost per student.

Business and administrative expenditures excluding capital outlay, include Board of Education, superintendent, office of

the principal (school administration), fiscal services, other business services, communication services, human resources, technology services and building and site improvement services.

SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER HONORED BY STATE ASSOCIATION

Mason Board of Education member, Patrick O'Connor has been honored by the Michigan Association of School Boards (MASB) for his efforts to improve his leadership skills, demonstrating his commitment to student achievement and his own continuous improvement.

Mr. O'Connor received both a Certified Board Member Award and an Award of Merit from MASB at the April 11 Board Meeting. Awards are earned for classes completed in MASB's leadership training program, as well as for conference attendance, years of service and leadership activities.

This training and professional development helps board members keep pace with the fast-moving and complex changes in public education. Last year, more than 1,300 school board members statewide participated in MASB's professional development program for elected school leaders. The hours devoted to this training are above and beyond the time members spend at their local meetings, events, and reviewing policies and board packets.
