Grades and financial need will be considered but are not the only deciding factors. The ideal candidate(s) would be one that is pursuing similar interests to Amanda and can demonstrate challenges that they may have had to overcome in either their personal or school life.

To be considered, each applicant must:

- Complete the entire application provided below.
- One letter of recommendation from a MHS teacher.
- One letter of recommendation from an adult, non-family member who can outline why the applicant is deserving of the scholarship.
- Potentially participate in an interview with ABTCL Board Members (top few candidates only).
