

Student Responsibilities

Improper student behavior on a bus can cause a driver to be distracted and endanger the bus and its passengers. Student responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

Students will:

1. Observe same conduct as in the classroom.
2. Be courteous to others. Demonstrate responsible behavior through positive social interactions while on the bus. Use no profane or verbally abusive language.
3. Do not eat or drink on the bus. Smoking, possessing illegal substances and weapons are not allowed on the bus.
4. Cooperate with the driver and follow the driver's instructions the first time they are given.
5. Remain seated at all times while the bus is in motion. Students should sit facing forward and remain inside the seating compartment.
6. Keep head, hands and feet inside the bus.
7. Do not be destructive. Students/parents shall be charged for intentional damage to the interior or exterior of the bus.
8. Arrive at their designated bus stop at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled arrival time. Buses will not wait for tardy students.
9. The bus driver is authorized to assign seats.
