## Student Responsibilities

Improper student behavior on a bus can cause a driver to be distracted and endanger the bus and its passengers. Student responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

## Students will:

- Observe same conduct as in the classroom.
- 2. Be courteous to others. Demonstrate responsible behavior through positive social interactions while on the bus. Use no profane or verbally abusive language.
- 3. Do not eat or drink on the bus. Smoking, possessing illegal substances and weapons are not allowed on the bus.
- 4. Cooperate with the driver and follow the driver's instructions the first time they are given.
- 5. Remain seated at all times while the bus is in motion. Students should sit facing forward and remain inside the seating compartment.
- 6. Keep head, hands and feet inside the bus.
- 7. Do not be destructive. Students/parents shall be charged for intentional damage to the interior or exterior of the bus.
- Arrive at their designated bus stop at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled arrival time. Buses will not wait for tardy students.
- 9. The bus driver is authorized to assign seats.
