MI Safe Schools: Michigan's 2020-21 Return to School Roadmap

Ron shared the return to school roadmap, 3-page overview, and talking points.

Subcommittee Reports

Secondary Instruction - Lance and Ted

Ted reported that the state's roadmap aligns with the work of the subcommittee. The subcommittee plans to meet prior to the July 20 meeting.

HEC, Childcare and Preschool Instruction - Angie

Angie shared that early childhood enrollment is on target but kindergarten enrollment is light.

Maintaining Healthy Environments and Operations - Rick, Kevin Doty

Rick shared that the committee members have continued to work on signage, PPE needs, and procurement. Nick Toodzio is helping to coordinate the effort as District Healthy Environments Coordinator. Michael Koot reported on the airborne aspect of infection and inquired about the district's HVAC systems. Kevin Doty shared plans for increasing ventilation and more frequent replacement of filters in each building. Utilizing outdoor spaces is suggested. Band and choir will require additional review.

Food Service - Chris Salmon and Adrienne
